Welcome to the inaugural Bag Toss for the Red Cross! We appreciate your support of our great organization. Please stop and talk with the Red Cross staff that are in the park today for further opportunities to support the mission by volunteering your time and/or expertise. We truly thank you for coming and hope you have a great time!

Point System

- 3 Points for a bag that goes through the hole
- 1 Point for a bag that is on the playing surface
- 1 Point for a bag that is hanging into the hole
- 1 Point for a bag that is hanging off of the edge, but is not touching the ground
- 0 Points for a bag that is hanging off of the board AND is touching the ground
- 0 Points for a bag that is hanging off of the board AND is resting on another bag that is touching the ground

Everyone Wins!

Game Rules

- Partners shall stand at opposite boards
- A coin toss shall determine which team throws first at the start of the match
- Opposing teams shall alternate throws until all 8 bags have been thrown. All throws must be underhand.
- If a bag hits the ground and bounces on the board, it does not count and must be removed from the board
- Opposing points cancel, remaining points added to the game score for the team that scored them
- The team that scores the highest points on the previous round has honors and will throw first on the next round. If both teams have the same round score, then the game score stays the same and honors stays with the team who had it the previous round.
- Game ends when a team reaches 21 points exactly
- If a team exceeds 21 points, their game score is reduced to 15 points regardless of how far over 21 points they are, or what their game score was prior to exceeding 21 points.
- Teams are not required to throw at the board for it to be considered as a legal throw. Bags can be dropped or thrown to their teammate.
- If a player crosses the foul line during a throw, or throws out of turn, the throw the foul occurred on is void. If the bag is on the board, it must be removed. If it knocked another bag through the hole or off the board, the bag(s) that were knocked through the hole or off the board must be returned to previous board location(s).
- Time limits may be enforced, in order to stay on schedule (dependent upon number of teams registered).
