



## COMMUNITY RECYCLING CONTAINER

The City will offer a 20 yard community recycling container. The container will be located in the southeast corner of the Sheldon Community Services Center parking lot and accessible 24/7 as an additional recycling service. This will not replace the current curbside recycling program in Sheldon, but an addition for those interested in this service. The same recycling materials that are accepted curbside will be allowed in the container. We have included the Northwest Iowa Area Solid Waste Landfill recycling information. Please respect the use of this container for recycling materials only.

Mixed Paper	Office paper, Colored paper, Shiny paper, Envelope (transparent windows okay), junk mail, Catalogs (reduce to ½ inch thick), Newspapers, Brown paper bags, Magazines (reduce to ½ inch thick), Phone books (reduce to ½ inch thick), Shredded paper (bag it separately), Hardcover books (remove covers, reduce to ½ inch thick), Paperback books (reduce to ½ inch thick), Paper egg cartons	Food & Paper Waste	Frozen food & juice boxes, Food wrappers & bags, Dirty paper plates, napkins & cups, Food waste (uneaten food), Tissues, Paper towels, Wax paper
Plastic 	All plastic containers labeled 1-5, Milk & juice jugs, Pop & water bottles, Dish & Liquid soap bottles, Bleach & detergent containers, Ice cream tubs & yogurt cups, Cooking oil containers, Lotion bottles, Household cleaning containers (clean no liquids, lids, caps or pumps)	Plastic 	All plastic containers labeled 6-7, Plastic containers without numbers, Styrofoam & packing peanuts, Plastic bags, Plastic utensils, cups & plates, Disposable diapers, Plastic food wrapping, Tupperware containers, Medical supplies & sharps
Aluminum & Metals	Aluminum & tin cans (remove labels), Aluminum foil & pans, (Clean all cans, foil and pans. NO batteries or electronics)	Glass	NO glass will be accepted due to possible contamination of other materials.
Corrugated Cardboard	Corrugated cardboard only, Pizza boxes (must be clean, broken down and flattened)	Non-Corrugated Cardboard	Fiber board (e.g., cereal boxes), Wax-coated cardboard
