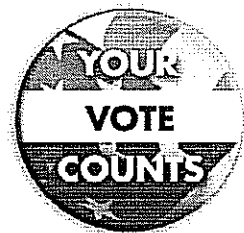
- The first day that election papers may be filed is August 29, 2011.
- The last day election papers may be filed is September 22, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.
- The voter registration deadline is October 28, 2011. All voter registration forms must be re-

ceived by the county auditor no later than 5 p.m. on October 28, 2011, unless postmarked on or before October 24, 2011.

- The deadline to request an absentee ballot by mail is November 4, 2011.
- The deadline to request & vote on absentee ballot in person at the County Auditor is November 7, 2011.
- The regular City election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2011. Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The City of Sheldon is seeking the contracted services of a Housing Rehabilitation Inspector to perform the following duties required by the City's Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation Grant Program. The Northwest Iowa Planning & Development Commissions (NWIPD) on behalf of the City will oversee the Housing Rehabilitation Inspector and assist them in performing these duties. Duties include but not limited to; performing pre-inspections, determining cost estimates, performing visual risk assessments for lead-based paint hazards, preparing written bid documents and specifications, complet-

ing payment requests, change orders, and conducting final inspections and lead-based paint clearance testing on ten owner-occupied units.
