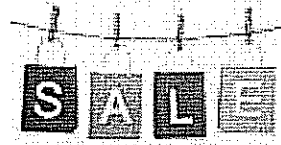
Garage Sale Ordinance

We would like to remind people, if you are having a garage sale, City Ordinance states the following:

- Such sale shall be held on premises owned or leased by at least one sale participant.
- Such sale shall not last for more than three (3) consecutive days at

any one location. There shall be a two (2) week period between garage sales/rummage sales/yard sales at any one location.

- Sale items and tables shall be enclosed in a building from sunset to sunrise.
- A violation of this sec-



tion is a simple misdemeanor or municipal infraction as set out in the City Code.

Don't Move Firewood

Our forests are threatened by nonnative insects that can kill large numbers of trees. Three recently introduced insects—emerald ash borer, Asian longhorned beetle, and Sirex woodwasp—are wood-infesting species that can be transported long distances in firewood. Once transported into new areas, these insects can become established and kill local trees.

We must STOP THE SPREAD of these insects and protect our forests and trees.

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

*Leave firewood at home—do not transport it to campgrounds or parks.

*Use firewood from local

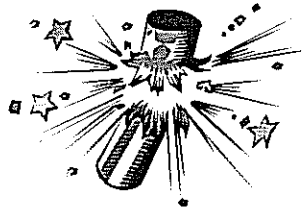
sources.
